

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting July 27 2017
(approved 8/17/2017)

The meeting was called to order at 7:15 pm. Present at the meeting: Selectmen Vern Worthen, Chris Tibbetts and Norman Redlevske; Tax Collector and Treasurer Yolanda Violette; Secretary Fran Varney.

Minutes - Approved July 13, 2017 minutes 3-0.

Roads:

- Residents on West Sandy River feel local traffic (vehicles and 4 wheeler) goes too fast on the road. Special needs individuals live on the road, and the possibility of a sign was discussed. Vern will call MDOT about the issue.
- Request for road repair work near culvert near Toth place.
- Request to clean out culvert near Campbell place.
- Contractor contacted town about his work on a new driveway and culvert (Gierczak place) on Beech Hill Road.
- Hole on Elm Street needs to be filled.
- Gerry removed tree that fell and blocked Bacon Road near Gardner place.
- Some of the above requests will require patch.
- Discussion about Brown Road, and possible widening to make more space during winter for snowplowing.

LRAP

- Due date of August 1, 2017 to certify 2016 LRAP project. Form was completed and signed.
- 2017 paving project is on Pike's to do list for summer work, but no specific date set.

Roadside mowing for next two years discussed.

- If 30 miles are contracted, then Rt 137 should be included
- Bush-hog work also available.

Warrant approved 3-0.

Tax collection 2017: Mil rates reviewed, 15.99 approved 3-0.

Mercer Community Center:

- 50 gallon water heater has been installed.
- On next meeting's agenda – look into gas furnace.
