

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting May 17, 2018

SAD #54:

Roads

- Issue on East Sandy River Road of resident blocking access to West Sandy River Road, in belief that it was discontinued. According to town records, maintenance on the portion of road in question is discontinued during winter season. Vern will speak to the son of the landowner.
