

Minutes of Selectmen's Meeting December 13, 2018
(approved January 10, 2019)

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm. Present at the meeting: Selectmen Chris Tibbetts and Norman Redlevske; Tax Collector and Treasurer Yolanda Violette; Secretary Fran Varney; Fred LaPlante.

Minutes from November 29, 2018 approved 2-0

Roads and culverts: A culvert (16 feet deep) near town forest on Elm Street overflowed onto road. Donnie took care of the road and ditch, but the ground is too frozen to fix the culvert problem. The culvert will have to wait until spring. Dig Safe! was notified a week ago, but has not been by yet.

Harvesting in the Town Forest: Gerry reported the net amount of town income to date is \$713.43
